


MA 182 INSTRUCTIONS


Read the entire instruction manual before starting so that you are familiar with the stages of assembly and the tools required at each step




TOOLS REQUIRED (Not Supplied)

- Phillips screwdriver
- Cordless Drill
- Masking tape
- Tape measure
- Pencil









STEP 3 Attaching Side Mount (2 Options)

Assembling Cap Set for Option 1


- Assemble all side mount Cap Sets (4 Sets),
- Connect the Side Mount Connector (11) to the top and bottom of the cap set. (as shown in the diagram)

Mounting Option A Attaching to the side of the console through the Side Clamp.






- a. Undo the screws in the Side Clamps (8)&(9)
- b. Place the drill bit into the holes of the Bottom Side Clamp and mark position of where to drill on the console (Ensuring no wiring inside the console will be damaged)
- c. Using the provided drill bit, drill holes through the Side Clamp and console (on your marked positions)
- d. Place Bolt (16) through each of the Bottom Side Clamps, connecting them through the Side Mount Cap set you assembled earlier (as shown in the Figure 1)
- e. Fasten to the inside of the console using nut (13) and washer (14) (as shown in the Figure 1)
- f. Repeat above steps for the other side


- Assemble all side mount Cap Sets (4 Sets),
- Connect the Side Mount Connector (11) to the top and bottom of the cap set. (as shown in the diagram)



Mounting Option B

Attaching to the side of the console through the alloy frame.

- a. Just above the Bottom Side Clamps, Mark suitable position on both the Rear Upright and console (Ensuring no wiring inside the console will be damaged)
- b. Using the provided Drill Bit, drill holes through both marked positions
- c. Place Bolt (16) through each of the holes connecting them through the tube and Cap Set into the console. (as shown in the Figure 1)
- d. Fasten to the inside of the console using nut (13) and washer (14) (as shown in the Figure 2)
- f. Repeat above steps for the other side



STEP 4



- a. Using the provided Drill Bit, drill holes through the Upright Rear into the floor of the boat.
- **b.** Fix Screws to the floor of the boat. (These screws are not provided You will need to source your own screws, as there will be different screws required depending on the material your boat floor is made from)
